

### YouTube Live

Your GCC email account gives you access to YouTube's Studio, which allows you to capture video with your web camera.

#### On a PC or Macintosh:

1. Point your web browser to <http://www.youtube.com>
2. Sign in with your GCC email address and password
3. Click "Go live" under the "Create a video or post" menu



(The first time you click this link on your PC or Mac, you will be prompted to set up your channel, and most of these steps can be bypassed by clicking the "Set up later" option.)

**You must also create your channel and verify your account 24 hours before you plan to record.**

4. You will be prompted to allow studio.youtube.com access to your web camera and microphone
5. On the "Webcam stream info" dialogue box, add a title and change the privacy setting from "Public" to "Unlisted"
6. Click "Next"
7. You will be prompted to "smile," then you will see the "Go live" button
8. When you are done, click ""END STREAM"
9. Click "EDIT IN STUDIO"

Your video will appear under the "Live" tab on your list of videos in studio.youtube.com.

#### On your mobile devices:

In spring 2020, YouTube disabled mobile user from "going live," so you must:

1. Open the YouTube app and Sign in with your GCC email address
2. Tap the camera icon next to your avatar.
3. Tap "RECORD"
4. Tap the record button to begin, then the end button to stop.
5. Tap next
6. Add a title and description, and make sure the privacy is set to "Unlisted"
7. Tap "Upload"
8. Notice as well that you can upload other videos stored on your device.

Your video will appear under the "Uploads" tab on your list of videos in studio.youtube.com.

You can manage the live videos in studio.youtube.com and copy and paste them into Moodle as you can any other YouTube video.
