# Syllabus Workflow

- 1. Create a word processing file in Google Docs or Word (following the guidelines)
- 2. Run the accessibility checker
  - 1. "Accessibility Checker" in Word
  - 2. Install the "Grackle Docs" extension in Google Docs
- 3. Fix any errors
- 4. Save the file as a PDF (avoid "for printing" if given a choice)
- 5. Upload the PDF as a File to Moodle, open in a "New window"

This is the general workflow for \*most\* documents as well.

# In general...

### Create the file

Use styles (headers & lists)

Only use tables with header rows

Avoid decorative images

Avoid text as images

Alt text your images

Check color contrast


Avoid color-only for important information


Export as PDF



# Avoid Text as Image





Fig. 7 Agent Environment Model. The model shows how the agent and the environment interact with each other. The agent takes an action on the environment which then sends a state and a reward to the agent


### Alternative text

Read by screen readers

Helps you manage missing files

In most word processors, right click to see the alternative text pane.






### **Check Color Contrast**
